CHRO Vitesco Technologies
(since 1st October 2019)

As a result of the organisational realignment of the Continental Powertrain division, Ingo Holstein will take over the management of Vitesco Technologies as Chief Human Resources Officer (CHRO) from the 1st of October 2019 onwards.

Previously, he was appointed head of Human Relations (HR) of the Continental Powertrain division in January 2019. Before this, he had been head of HR in the Tires division since 2010. He has extensive expertise in business organization through human resources work as well as in executive support and development.

After studying political sciences at Freie Universität Berlin, Germany, he joined Continental AG in Hanover as an HR specialist in 1992. In 2000, he took on the role of head of HR at Continental's headquarters and the German tire trade organization Vergölst. In addition he headed the recruiting office of Continental. In 2005, Mr. Holstein was promoted to head of HR Corporate Functions, being responsible for HR principles and policies for the Continental group. In this function, Continental appointed him in 2007 as HR project lead for the integration of Siemens VDO. Later he additionally assumed responsibility for talent management, before being appointed head of Human Relations for the Tire division in 2010. Ingo Holstein represents Continental AG in the bargaining committee of the employer association of the chemical industry in Germany (Große Tarifkommission des BAVC) and is member of the executive board of the Leibniz-Fachhochschule Hannover.
